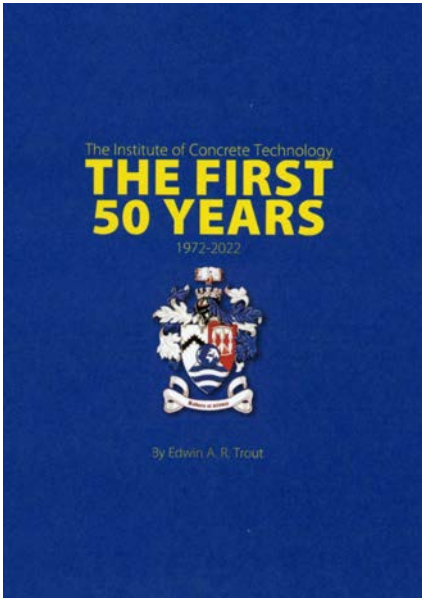

## A History of the Institute of Concrete Technology **The First 50 Years** 1972-2022

It traces the establishment and early development of the then Association of Concrete Technologists, its transformation into the Institute of Concrete Technology in 1978 and its steady growth in the 1980s under the presidency of Jim Wootten. International expansion in the 1990s follows, then a period of falling membership as the concrete industry in the UK consolidated during the ‘Noughties’ and, in 2007, the decision to merge with The Concrete Society. The foundations of recovery under Peter Hewlett’s presidency in 2008-15 are described and, post-merger, the most recent (and ongoing) period of expansion outlined.
